**Rayconnect Gets the Gold!**  
**Awarded Prestigious LEED® Green Building Certification**



Rochester Hills, MI – Rayconnect, Inc. announced today that it has been awarded LEED Gold Certification, making it one of few manufacturing facilities in the State of Michigan to receive this award. Established by the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) and verified by the Green Building Certification institute (GCBI), LEED is the nation’s preeminent program for the design, construction, and operation of high performance green buildings.

“One of our main goals was to build a facility that would demonstrate our commitment to environmental responsibility, and that is what drove every aspect in the design and construction of the facility,” states Earl Brown, President, Rayconnect, Inc.



Bumler Mechanical, Inc. and BASS worked with KIRCO, KIRCO MANIX and the construction team designing and installing the heating, ventilating and air conditioning (HVAC) for this 80,000 square foot, state-of-the-art manufacturing facility in Rochester Hills, Michigan. Bumler installed high efficiency rooftop air handling equipment with environmentally-friendly refrigerant, special filtration, humidification, and in some areas, laminar flow air diffusion to meet the design needs of the facility as well as meet

stringent LEED criteria. During the building's construction, 40% of materials used were from regional sources, and an additional 30% of materials were from recycled content. As an end result the construction team successfully diverted 75% of construction waste to recycling plants.

“We are proud to have Rayconnect, Inc. in our community, their success in obtaining this certification will hopefully serve as a model for those existing and new businesses who are trying to achieve higher environmental standards,” states Mayor Bryan Barnett. “We are excited to be a part of this celebration, and congratulate them for receiving this prestigious award.”

Rayconnect, Inc. achieved LEED Gold certification for its reduction in energy use by 35%, a reduced water demand of 40%, having energy efficient lighting and HVAC equipment, recycled material use, as well as incorporating a variety of other sustainable strategies.
